Important Dates

Jan 10th – All trip logs for Oct, Nov & Dec are due so that your 4th Quarter IFTA reports can be filed by the filing deadline.

January – watch for your 2009 tags and decals to arrive in the mail. Remember you have a grace period through 2/28/09 to operate with your 2008 decals so long as your accounts are current and your renewal applications are filed.

Jan – March – Watch for miscellaneous tax forms from Arkansas and Kansas to arrive in your mail. **DO NOT IGNORE THEM!** If you would like our assistance just send the form to our office and we will help you! Penalties and interest are assessed if you do not respond.

Jan 31st – 4th Quarter IFTA reports due!

INCOME TAX PREPARATION SERVICES!

If you have NOT yet received your 2009 IFTA decals or New Mexico ID Permits, it may be due to delinquent tax filings or payments due. Delinquent accounts DO NOT have the grace period so be sure to buy trip permits!

Included with this newsletter is a letter from the DMV dated 12/3/2008. Keep a copy of this letter in your truck until you receive your 2009 Cab Cards and tags. It is the “Delay of Enforcement” granting a grace period through 2/28/2009 if your renewal application is complete and submitted to the DMV.

Next year please remember there will be **NO MORE GRACE PERIODS!** Now that renewal dates are staggered, you will need to complete all the paperwork in time that your new Cab Cards & stickers are in your possession by the renewal date.

IFTA Workshops!
