Important Dates

July 1st - 2009/2010 tax year 2290 can be e-filed

July 4th - Have a safe 4th of July holiday!

July 10th - Trip Logs from April 1 - June 30 are due in our office.

July 15th - DMV Renewal Applications and checks for clients whose DMV expires August 31, 2009 are due.

July 31 - 2nd Quarter Road Taxes must be postmarked today to avoid penalties.

August 31 - New York Hut Permit Renewals and 2290 Heavy Highway taxes are due.

**If your DMV tags expire August 31st
HEADS UP!!**

It is time to start renewal applications for tags expiring 8/31/2009!! If your 2009 Registration expires 8/31/09 and you have not heard from us please give us a call and we will start the renewal process right away

YOU WILL NOT HAVE A GRACE PERIOD!!

If you drive with expired tags on your truck you will be ticketed and fined!! Unlike years past, you cannot wait until the due date to pay your fees and submit your application for renewal!

It's time to prepare your annual 2290's

This year, the IRS is mandating that all carriers with over 25 vehicles e-file their Form 2290 - the Heavy Highway Vehicle Use Tax.

New York HUT Series 19 expires November 30, 2009 and New York HUT Series 20 renewal fees are due no later than August 31, 2009.

If you have a NYHUT permit and have not provided us with your renewal letter, please mail or fax it to us at your earliest convenience.

NEW DMV Requirements

The DOT has implemented the PRISM Program (Performance & Registration Information System Management) that allows the DOT to keep track of who is responsible for the safe operation of each vehicle.

If you are registering any vehicle that is not being operated under your own authority you may be affected by this change. The DMV is now requiring the DOT number at the vehicle level be the motor carrier responsible for the safety of the vehicle as registered with the FMCSA.

If you are using someone else's DOT number or others are using your DOT number and need additional information please call our office. If you are not providing correct DOT numbers on your DMV registration it will hold up the processing of your DMV renewal.
