Important Dates

March—the Grace Period for IFTA has expired! If you do not have your 2010 IFTA decals, you must buy Trip Permits to be on the roads. We are still following-up for clients whose permits have not arrived. Remember, if tax returns or fees are outstanding the agencies will not release your 2010 permits.

March – Watch for miscellaneous tax forms from Arkansas and Kansas to arrive in your mail. **DO NOT IGNORE THEM!** You must file them even if you did not travel in those states. If you would like our assistance just send the form to our office and we will help you! Penalties and interest are assessed if you do not respond.

Mar 31st – Arkansas Carrier Reports Due!
Kansas Reports due ????

Apr 10th – All Trip Logs for January, February, & March due! The IFTA tax return for 1st Quarter is due April 30th.

Apr 15th – Income taxes are due. If you haven't turned in you organizer by March 25 you will need to go on extension. Please contact us if you need our help in requesting an extension

Apr 30th – IFTA Quarterly Reports due!!

UCR Update

2010 UCR registrations are still not being accepted. At this time all information to finalize registration is not complete. You will be notified when it is time to register and given adequate time to complete the process before enforcement begins. Right now, enforcement is limited to 2008-2009 UCR enrollment

If you do not have your 2009 credentials, purchase Trip Permits from any major truck stop or call Comdata at 800-749-6058.

CSA 2010

New FMCSA Safety Program

Launching July 2010

As part of A-Log's mission to raise awareness we want our clients to be prepared for **CSA 2010.**

Comprehensive Safety Analysis 2010 is a NEW FMCSA safety program with NEW enforcement and compliance issues that will impact your business!

There will be 7 Behavior Analysis and Safety Improvement Categories (BASICS) used to evaluate and rank your safety fitness. This new Safety Measurement System (SMS) uses all safety-based violations recorded during roadside inspections to identify carriers who need to address safety problems before crashes occur. It's primary purpose is to make the roads safer for motor carriers and the public.

The new measurement system is more comprehensive, will update carriers scores on a monthly basis and will support an intervention process (investigations) designed to more efficiently and effectively correct safety problems. Offsite investigations will be conducted over the phone and through e-mail, fax and snail mail so do not ignore or set aside letters from the FMCSA!
