EXPIRATION DATES!

Listed below are *typical* expiration dates for the most common permits of our clients.

Take note and plan ahead !

Expiration dates are staggered and not the same for everyone, look at your permits and fill in the blank. Keep this as a guide for the coming year.

Don't forget your 3rd Quarter IFTA Tax returns are due **November 2, 2009**. All tax returns must be filed and all taxes paid before your 2010 IFTA decals will be issued
